Cleaning & Car Care

Fabric sun roof

Clean the sun roof with soapy water and a sponge, using a soft brush to remove stubborn dirt. Rinse off and dry with a chamois leather. Do not use any abrasive cleaner or stain remover on the roof surface.

CAUTION: If using a jet wash, avoid directing the jet towards the seal between the sun roof and the roof.

The sealing rubber should be treated with a rubber preservative in the spring and autumn.

Open the roof and clean any dust, dirt and foreign matter from the sun roof frame and water channels with a small brush.

Lightly grease the sliding parts occasionally with an acid-free grease such as Vaseline.

CAUTION: The application of too much grease can cause the sun roof to stick and in time damage the roof mechanism.

Lamp lenses

Lamp lenses, excluding headlamps, are manufactured from plastic and should be cleaned with soap and water only.

CAUTION: To avoid damage do not use Glass Cleaner GAC 2066 or Screenwash fluid GAC 2067/8 to clean the plastic lamp lenses or other plastic materials.

Cabriolet hood

Washing and cleaning the hood

Use a soft brush to remove dust and dirt prior to washing.

Soak with soap and water to soften encrusted dirt before rinsing the hood with clean water.

IMPORTANT!

NEVER wash the car in an automatic car wash or with a high pressure hose.

ONLY use mild soap solutions to wash or clean the hood. NEVER use spirit, petroleum or chlorine based cleaning agents, or wash/wax compounds.

To remove stubborn particles of fluff from the hood (not the screen), lightly press (and then remove) sticky tape to the affected area.

Note: In wet or muddy driving conditions, road dirt will collect beneath the leading edge of the hood where it fits against the windscreen surround, and may cause staining of the fabric. Open the hood from time to time and wash the affected area.

Washing and cleaning the rear screen

The rear screen is susceptible to scratching from the effects of dirt and grit. For this reason it is important to wash the screen frequently using plenty of water, and to avoid opening and closing the hood when it is very dirty.
